DAN'S THUNDER PLAY void early speed, between horses stretch, improved position. LUCKY DOOBEH void early speed, failed to menace. WEE PROSPECT set pace, stopped. GOLD IT WILL B unhurried early, no threat. COOKIE JO off slowly, no factor.
