HIGH SOLIDS tracked the leader from the outside, came to even terms turning for home and contentiously duelled with MR. LOGAN the length of the stretch and inched to the front late. MR. LOGAN was hustled to the front soon after the start, set all the pace to the quarter pole, dug in to duel with the winner through the stretch and came up a little short. ELVISHASLEFTHEBLDG raced in the middle of the pack to the turn, bid four wide and closed with interest without menacing the top ones. ROCKY JOE lagged well back in the early going, rallied inside through the turn and found his best stride too late. SAY DUBAI BYE had some speed to the stretch and had little response when needed. RUN KELEN RUN rushed up on the inside to loom boldly nearing the quarter pole and weakened. RIVER BEND LADD saved ground to no avail. SEDONA SILVER showed some early speed then gradually gave way. THE PRINCE AND I slow into stride and wide through the turn, could not reach contention. ONE BLASTED STORM was never a factor.
