MUSIC APPEAL was settled for a half mile, bid three wide on the second turn then closed steadily in the drive and prevailed. SECRET JACKPOT was on the pace three wide for six furlongs, responded to mid stretch, led to deep stretch but weakened late and just saved the place3. TITIAN had no speed, bid three wide on the second turn, swung widest in the drive and was closing well albeit too late. LODI RED got fanned four wide to the backstretch, stalked the pace to the second turn, rallied three wide to the stretch but lost his punch in the last eighth of a mile. TWAIN'S TITAN was near the pace in the opening quarter but got outkicked down the backstretch, raced two wide to the stretch but could not muster a late response. LETSGETITRIGHT was on the pace while two wide to the second turn, remained off the rail to the stretch then tired.
