OMEGA CODE stalked TIMELY JEFF to the middle of the turn, came to even terms just past the quarter pole, shook loose and quickly pulled away to win easily. SMOKIN MIKE raced mid pack, came four wide through the turn and rallied willingly for the place while no match for the winner. SEEMORE SEEMORE raced in the second tier, came three wide and closed well for the show. TIMELY JEFF sprinted to an open lead, held sway to the quarter pole and weakened late. EYES OF MOSCOW was off a step slow, gained on the leaders to the turn and finished evenly. JOLTIN VINCE was slow into stride and closed much too late. ONEBADSHARK tracked the leader for a half mile and came up empty. TUFF RAY was never a factor. TIZZA DUDE showed little.
