Footnotes

DANCING YODELER got outsprinted to the turn, bid three wide mid turn then was crowded and forced to check nearing the quarter pole, found room into the stretch, rallied inside rivals through the drive and prevailed. BAILMEOUTBUGSY stalked the leaders to the turn, got fanned out to the four path but rallied into the stretch, dueled to mid stretch, responded to deep stretch then was bested. SOUND OF MONEY had no speed, bid three then four wide to the stretch and was gaining ground steadily late. SIDEPOCKET LOU flashed good speed, dueled for the lead to the turn, inched away while off the rail to the stretch, resisted to deep stretch but was tiring in the late stages. MALIBU CANYON attended the pace to the turn, got outkicked three wide to the stretch and tired through the final furlong. TUDOR BLUE had his head turned when the gates opened and broke about three lengths last, was hustled inside to get into contention, remained a factor to the quarter pole but stopped in the drive.
