DEWRAG was a bit slow from the gate and lagged early, advanced while racing off the rail to the stretch then was behind a wall of horses in upper stretch, angled out for room, rallied once clear then closed with a rush in the final sixteenth to be along in time. SOLAR TEX was a pace factor between horses and two wide, dueled for the lead to mid stretch, edged away from EL MARIACHI in deep stretch but could not stall the winner. EL MARIACHI contested the pace three wide to the stretch, continued to to duel to inside the furlong grounds then weakened in the final sixteenth. IN A WINE TIZZY chased the leaders to the turn, came three wide to the stretch then also eased out for room in upper stretch but could not muster the needed late response. TRAWEEK was also chasing to the turn, raced three wide to the stretch then eased widest in upper stretch and was making a mild bid late. AL FAATIK had no speed, came two wide to the stretch but lost his punch leaving mid stretch. LUCKBOX SAM tracked the leaders while saving ground to the stretch then failed to rally in the drive. BAY STREET flashed speed from the rail to the stretch then tired.
