NATIONAL EMBLEM raced in the middle of the pack to the middle of the final turn, came to even terms while four wide turning for home and edged clear. AEROJACK rushed up inside, set the pace to the quarter pole and could not hold off the winner late while weakening. WIDE OUT raced in the middle of the pack, rallied three wide and flattened. GOLD VALUE was off a step slow, lagged and closed willingly on the outside much to late. CRESCO PRIME TIME broke outward, pulled to the front before the first turn, dropped back slightly to attend the pace and gave way in the drive. INTELLIGENT MALE raced unhurriedly to the final turn, bid five wide and faltered. WHITE MARK tracked the leaders from the inside, was checked in tight quarters entering the final turn and could not regain his momentum.
