**Footnotes**

CHIEF LITTLE MAN showed good early speed, dropped back sharply early in the turn, came on again while six wide and edged clear late. ENGINE SIXTY NINE came into contention while three wide on the turn, assumed a short lead near the furlong pole but was outfinished late. MUQTABE edged to the front in the early going, set the fractions to the furlong pole and weakened. EMERALDS BOY tracked the leader from the inside, remained close to the lane but could not gain late. DEFYING LOGIC was slowest to find his stride and showed some late interest much too late. SAXMAN raced in the middle of the pack and did not threaten. WINFIELD was never in contention. C'MON MARQUIS showed some speed to the stretch and stopped quickly.
