Footnotes

CHELE was hustled to the front, set all the pace to the stretch, kicked away to mid stretch then was kept to task to hold. I C SPUTNIK chased the pace to the turn, rallied three wide to the stretch then closed ground steadily in the final furlong. DRAW TWO BUCK also chased the winner two wide to the stretch and finished willingly late. RAZZ ATTACK had no speed, was fanned four wide on the turn and was making up ground belatedly. PARTNERSHIP PAYOUT also was outrun to the turn, bid inside to mid turn then was boxed inside, had to steady off of GREY RAE'S heels at the quarter pole, shifted three wide and could not make an impact in the drive. WHITE MARK had no speed and was outrun. CEILING ZERO stalked the pace two wide to the stretch but weakened in the drive. UNCLE LOUIE was never far back to the turn, offered a bid three wide mid turn but gave out after a half mile. GREY RAE was used early, pressed the winner to mid turn from the rail then tired and stopped in the stretch.
