APRIL lagged to the middle of the turn, began her bid four wide, crept up and wore down the leader late. EVIE JO was well back to the turn, rallied five wide, came to even terms with the leader nearing the furlong pole, took command but then could not hold off APRIL in the final yards. HEART'S MUSIC raced in the middle of the field from the start, could not match strides with the front ones and had to settle for the show. STYLEFREE raced three wide through the first turn while setting the pace, continued in command to the eighth pole and weakened. PAPIKA RED broke the quickest, remained in contention to the middle of the turn and faltered. LIVING LEGEND showed little. MARDI'S TOUGH GAME attended the pace from the inside to the stretch and gave way.
