Footnotes

HAPPY RAINBOW forwardly placed from the outside, stalked early pace, advanced then joined leaders three deep exiting the turn, reached the front nearing eighth marker and edged away. PROPER DATE was hustled to the front and controlled the early pace, dug in when challenged on the turn and into the stretch and could not match the winner in the drive. PRINCESS MOBILE prompted the early issue while outside pacesetter, engaged leader on the turn then was between rivals entering the stretch but lost contact with top pair in final eighth. MISS BOBBIE BEAR broke in slightly, tucked in behind the leaders, remained inside into the stretch but lacked needed late response. COUNTRY COUNTESS reserved from well off the fence, outside rival leaving the backstretch, angled in some on the turn, came back out in the stretch but never menaced. DAZE settled from between foes then outside rival, raced three then four wide into the stretch and did not threaten. PERSIAN KITTEN was washy in the post parade, broke a step slow, chased from the inside into the stretch, came out some and was not late factor.
