CODY'S ENCORE was always close, saved ground to the middle of the turn, swung out for the drive, and rallied steadily to be up in time. LILL TRINA pressured the pace from the start, took command early in the stretch but could not hold off the winner in the late going. GOTTA GO GAL steadied nearing the half mile pole and was shuffled back, rallied five wide through the turn and closed with interest for the show. HOPE RIVER appeared to outbreak the gate and set all the pace to the quarter pole but weakened in the drive. FIRST ENDEVOR raced in the middle of the pack and did not menace. BETSTUSHELLY was never a factor. BLAINE INSPIRED broke alertly and dropped back quickly. ROYALE REGAL showed speed for a half mile and gave out quickly. ROSE AVENUE was awkward into stride and always outrun.
