SPOONEX broke alertly, emerged as the leader from a tightly grouped field before the half mile pole and gamely maintained the front to the end. MARKAY CREEK was slowest into stride, then raced well back to the turn, rallied five wide and closed very willingly for the place. PRIVATE PARK attend the pace from the outside, was unable to match strides with the top two but held the show. STRAWBERRY SUN FUN raced in the middle of the pack, rallied five wide through the turn but could not quite reach contention. MYSTIC MANDATE also was in the middle of the pack and had little late response. WAIT 'N SEA tracked from the inside but could not rally. PRIMA FIGLIA saved ground to mid stretch, shifted out for running room and flattened. SEATTLE BRASH LISA was never a factor.
