METTLER STATION broke alertly, set a contentious pace to the stretch, opened a clear lead by mid stretch and was forced to dig in through the late going to just hold off the fast closing KELLY'S GOLDEN WON. KELLY'S GOLDEN WON never far back, came three wide through the turn, found his best stride at mid stretch and was gaining with each stride but ran out of race track. FIVE A DAY dueled to the stretch between rivals but could not match strides with the top one and weakened late. PEANUT BUTTER BOY dueled between rivals to the middle of the turn and gradually gave way. TWISTED WINDSOCKS was four wide through the turn and closed evenly. OLD STANDARD slow into stride and did not reach contention. EXKLEMATION EL showed brief speed to get the first call and quickly gave way.
