Footnotes

NATURAL DREAMS prompted the pace to the head of the stretch while racing three wide, took command before the furlong pole and pulled away. INVESTMENT GRADE was always close, pressed the pace while racing four wide but could not match strides with the winner late. RED POWDER dueled between rivals to the middle of the turn, then weakened late. J'S STORMTRACKER raced unhurriedly to stretch and rallied mildly without impacting the top ones. GUMMY RUNNER rushed to the lead soon after the start, set a contentious pace to the stretch and gradually gave way. SEENOSMOKE raced in the middle of the pack to the stretch while four wide and did not rally. GOOD AS IT GETS was never a factor. BOOGIE BUTT raced up close the the middle of the turn and came up empty.
