LEGAL VICTORY was unhurried for a half, bid two wide into the second turn, waited in traffic nearing the quarter pole, shifted out into the stretch, rallied when clear and outfinished CITY CHAPEL late. CITY CHAPEL The latter was off a step slow and had no speed, settled to the second turn, got fanned four wide while rallying to the stretch then was outkicked by the winner in the late stages. SIBERIAN RUSH was on the pace between rivals to the second turn, inched away to a short lead to the stretch, responded to mid stretch but was weakening in the final sixteenth. KING ROAR was among the leaders three wide to the second turn, got outkicked to the stretch and finished evenly. MR RONALD V. CLOUD chased the pace to the second turn, tried to rally from the three path to the stretch but lacked the needed late response. ABSOLUTE COURAGE was inside horses while dueling for the lead, stayed a factor to the stretch then gave out.
