STARBOARDLIGHTS chased the pace to the turn, bid two wide to the stretch then responded when set down and closed steadily without the rider using the whip but under constant hand urging. HANDSOME HARVEY JR set the pace while off the rail to the stretch, responded to pressure to mid stretch then could not stall the winner. BET ON VICTOR had no speed, offered a bid three wide to the stretch then was gaining ground belatedly. BARREL KNOT also chased the pace, raced three wide to the stretch and had a mild late rally. LEAVE IT TO CHANCE stalked the pace three wide to the stretch but tired in the final furlong. OUR SHORTY pressed the pace to the turn, was four wide to the stretch, stopped in mid stretch, was eased then walked off.
