CUVEE DIRECT had no early speed, worked forward, edged up four wide through the final turn and found her best stride in the lane to pull clear late. JAN THE FIRST attended the pace to the lane, dug in for the drive but could not reach the front. C T'S SUNSHINE GAL set all the pace to the furlong pole and suddenly flattened. CREME RINSE attended the pace from the outside for a half mile and weakened. FATAL EDGE showed little. PRINCESS LUCAY showed very brief speed, dropped back quickly, was eased in the stretch and walked off. SERENE SERENA bid inside on final turn, hit the rail near the sixteenth pole, fell and was vanned off.
