FOX IN THE HOUSE rushed up on the inside before the final turn, was blocked to the middle of the turn, waited, shifted out three wide when clear and closed gamely splitting rivals in the final strides. POINTED HOME raced in the middle of the pack throughout and closed gamely between to be up for the place. WARREN'S JACK V. attended the pace from the start but could not get to the front in a very compact field. KING'S QUEST showed early speed, dropped back on the turn but came on again late. DROUMERAGH (GB) sped to the front soon after the start, set all the fractions to the furlong pole but could not hold. PRANCIN' N DANCIN' was content to lag to the final turn, bid five wide turning for home and closed willingly on the outside but too late. DA NICKY raced in the middle of the pack and did not rally. HOLD THE PEACE was close up to the stretch and came up empty. AVIAN LU raced wide through bot turns, pulled up soon after the wire and was vanned off.
