ONE ROYAL STAR raced in the middle of the pack to mid turn, was blocked by a wall of horses, shifted out for racing room edged up to come to even terms with the leader and slowly came to the front. WILD CYCLE pressed the lead to the middle of the turn, put that one away, was joined by the winner at the furlong pole and grudgingly gave way. DAVE'S PACEMAKER lagged to the turn, came five wide, worked forward but could not catch the top two. SOUND OF MONEY raced in the middle of the field and along the rail but did not rally. HIGH STANDARDS chased the leaders to the stretch, four wide through the turn and weakened. SIBERIAN COCKTAIL rushed to the early lead, remained in contention to the middle of the turn and gradually gave way. GET YOUR SHINEBOX was never a factor. EDIT THIS showed brief speed, the dropped back quickly on the turn.
