Footnotes

ROAD TO KISSES reserved for a half mile, rallied four wide through the final turn, assumed command when CROSSFIRE TRAIL bolted and was kept to task to hold off the closers. FLYING was fanned wide into the first turn, raced unhurriedly down the backstretch, responded to urging five wide through the second turn and closed well for the place. CROSSFIRE TRAIL dueled with WATCH MY SIX for a quarter mile, assumed command on an easy lead to late in the final turn, bolted suddenly to the far outside, slowly recovered, began to rally but was weakening late while drifting in. OUR GAL IRISH raced in the middle of the pack to the second turn, loomed on the outside after three quarters of a mile and flattened in the drive. NEFERTIRI showed little. WATCH MY SIX dueled on the front end for a quarter mile, remained close to the stretch and gave out. DANCING FAIRY was squeezed back soon after the start and never a factor. GO FOR LAUNCH showed brief speed and gave out near the half mile pole to finish far back.
