SIGN UP rushed up two wide to attend the pace, shifted out four wide on the turn to challenge the leaders and closed willingly but could not match strides with the top one. STORM MAGIC loomed in the middle of the turn three wide, came to even terms, was held at bay while he asked hard left handed and weakened slightly at the end. LIT DE BET race in the middle of the field, two wide through the turn and had little response in the drive. PERFECT SOULMATE saved ground to no avail. SHEZA SCREAMER lagged to the turn, came up inside, was checked off heels, swung out five wide when clear and rallied mildly without impacting the outcome. ITALIAN SPIRIT was never a factor. DID IT PERFECT rushed up to attend the pace to the turn, then gave out.
