IDLE CHATTER was reserved to the turn, bid two wide through the final turn, dueled with DONTMESROUNDWIT JIM to the final strides and edged to the front. DONTMESROUNDWITJIM dueled with AUGMENT through the first turn, edged clear, held sway to the late going, was joined by the winner and weakened in the final strides. STORMY SURGE lagged to the stretch, came two wide and rallied mildly without menacing the front two. AUGMENT dueled through the first turn and gradually gave way. WILD CYCLE raced in the middle of the pack to the final turn three wide and came up empty. ALABAMA BOY crept up one the backstretch to challenged the pace to the quarter pole and stopped.
