SOLANA SOLEIL was outsprinted to the turn, rallied inside to mid turn, shifted off the rail into the stretch then closed ground steadily through the drive and prevailed. MINOU'S TOPPER chased the pace to the turn, got fanned four wide to the stretch then also finished willingly but could not catch the winner. LIGHTNING MCQUE set the pace from the off the rail to the stretch, responded to mid stretch then weakened in the late stages. TRUCO LATINO prompted the pace to the turn, bid three wide to the stretch but came up empty in the drive. SOUTH FORTY tracked the leader to the turn, was two wide to mid turn, shifted to the rail into the stretch but also failed to respond through the drive. MINISTER EXPRESS broke in, bumped the winner and stumbled then seemed to be disinterested, dropped far back and was eased through the stretch but walked off.
