**Footnotes**

ONE MO chased the leader to the turn, rallied two wide and pushed to the front into the stretch, edged away to mid stretch then held under steady urging. CITY CHAPEL was outrun to the turn, came three wide to the stretch, swung out in upper stretch, got forced wider by RUNNINFORBACKPAY leaving the furlong grounds but surged late to get second. RUNNINFORBACKPAY was outsprinted to the turn, raced two wide to the stretch, shifted out for room, was rallying then was crowded when STREET CAR lugged out, had to check nearing the sixteenth pole, angled in for room and finished willingly. STREET CAR chased the pace to the turn, raced two wide to the stretch, rallied to mid stretch then lugged out under left handed urging, crowded rivals but straightened late and was finishing well. NO TEAM SPIRIT was outrun to the turn, bid three wide then swung out into the stretch and closed steadily late. WARREN'S RAIL BIRD had no speed, raced off the rail to the stretch then shifted out and was also gaining late. BIGBARI had no speed, raced two wide to the stretch but was not a late threat. CLASSIC CRUSADER also had no speed and saved ground to no avail. MAGOO sprinted clear in the opening furlong, had a sizable lead to the turn then began to tire and stopped in the stretch. EXPENSIVE PENS was outrun to the turn, came four wide to the stretch but was not a factor.
