IMA KOOL STAR was out alertly and dueled for the lead outside of the runnerup, responded to urging and pushed away from that one to mid stretch then was kept to task to the line. STORMING KENTUCKY was hustled and helped carve out the pace inside the winner, saved ground but was outrun in upper stretch then had enough left to hold the place. COMPANY MEETING tracked the leaders to the turn, saved ground to the stretch then did not threaten the winner but was closing for second. SOUTH FORTY had no speed, raced three deep to the stretch but lacked a closing response. BI TOMORROW chased the top two to the turn, got fanned out four wide to the stretch but also failed to rally. BLACK HOOF EXPRESS was in good position chasing the leaders to the turn, tried to rally three wide to the stretch but weakened in the drive. HE'S BUSTED had no speed and was outrun. NORTHERN SOUL was outsprinted, chased three wide to the stretch then gave way. MASTERS CALL broke a step slow then showed little.
