Footnotes

BLUE MOON HIGH was rated patiently for a half mile, responded when roused into the second turn, circled rivals five wide to the stretch, to terms in mid stretch then inched clear in the final fifty yards. CLEVER COPY set the pace to the half, was headed between calls nearing the second turn, responded and inched clear again to the stretch, battled the winner when engaged a furlong out but was bested late while finishing determinedly. TASMANIAN TANNER stalked the pace to the second turn, rallied three wide to the stretch, was just off the top two to mid stretch then was outfinished late. JANUARY'S LADY had no speed, raced three wide on the second turn but came up empty in the drive. BOOT N IT pressed the pace to the middle of the backstretch, briefly stuck a head in front between calls then was outkicked by the runnerup to the second turn, tired and gave way. FANCEY ENDEAVOR was four wide early, tracked the pace to the half, offered her best try four wide to the stretch then faded. RAISE AGAIN had no speed and was not a factor.
