YOU KNOW WE KNOW set all the pace from off the rail to the stretch, responded to pressure to deep stretch then could not stall the winner. JUST METEOR prompted the action to the turn, offered his best try three wide to the stretch, could not make an impact and weakened through the final furlong. MY MAIN MAN broke a bit slow, chased the pace to the turn then was four deep to the stretch and gave way. MY COUNT SILVER tracked the pace to the turn, came two wide to the stretch but tired. DEVIL ON THE MOVE saved ground to no avail. THECURLYHAIREDDUDE had no speed and was not a factor. SENOR NAVA was never a threat.
