MY T QUICK tracked well back, gradually closed the gap, took command just after the furlong pole and edged clear. RED COATS R COMIN broke outward, pulled to a huge lead, drifted out when tiring in the late going but gamely held the place. COLONEL MUSTARD lagged for a half mile, gradually worked forward and closed willingly without menacing the top ones. MISSISSIPPI GOLD was off a step slow, raced mid pack to the stretch and closed with some interest without impacting the outcome. HOT TUB AARON chased the leaders to the quarter pole and gave way. MR. FURIOUS also chased the leaders for a half mile and came up empty. FOGGY DEW was never a factor.
