Footnotes

CHARLSIE'S SONG gained stalking position into first turn, tracked pacesetter from off the rail, bid alongside leader midway on second turn, gained lead then kicked clear and scored convincingly under steady handling. JESSIE WAS MINE was slow to begin, settled three wide, remained off the fence, angled four wide exiting the last turn, continued outside and was along late for the place. PROMISE ME FUN settled outside rival and off the pace, moved up between rivals into second bend, loomed later on that bend, remained off the fence and lost second. RED FORMAL stalked leaders from the inside, saved ground into the stretch, came out slightly in the drive but did not threaten. IMPRESSA VANESSA stalked while outside eventual winner into and through the backstretch, dropped back around second turn and weakened. LULITA broke out slightly, reserved from along the rail, later shifted out, chased four then five wide into the stretch but never menaced. COUNTRY COUNTESS stepped to the front, dictated the pace into the second turn, relinquished command midway on that bend and steadily gave way.
