INCREDIBLE YOU pulled to the front after the half mile pole, set all the rest of the pace, ducked in near the furlong pole, recovered quickly and kept all rivals at bay. IM TEZZING rushed to a short lead soon after the start, dueled with the winner to the stretch and could not match strides when more was needed. AUDACIOUSLY pressed the early pace, remained close to the stretch and closed evenly. LITELUCKY bid in the middle of the turn along the rail and faltered in the drive. CONTROVERSIALCOMET raced four wide through the turn and showed some interest too late. ELUSIVE BABE saved ground but could not reach contention. BLAINE ELEGANT had brief speed and gradually gave out. ROSE AVENUE raced five wide through the turn and was always outrun.
