SINGLE REASON was slow to find his best stride, edged up on the outside, bid four wide and closed willingly on the outside to be up in time. EL GRAN BULL broke the quickest, dueled between two rivals, kicked clear but was unable to hold off the fast closing SINGLE REASON in the final strides. TWAIN'S TITAN joined the leaders from the outside to duel three deep to the turn, loomed turning for home and weakened late. IRON WORKER GEORGE chased the front one while four wide and passed tiring rivals in the stretch. MATH WIZ rushed up to duel from the inside to the quarter pole, opened a clear lead and then gave way in the drive. YODELER BERT was not a factor. ORGANIC some speed to the turn, bid two wide and stopped in the drive.
