LONGVIEW DRIVE was a pace factor from the outset, bid three wide on the second turn, got bumped by the runnerup in upper stretch, recovered quickly, responded despite drifting out and was best. MARSHAL MARINI settled to the half, rallied four wide on the second turn, was up to duel into the stretch but drifted in, bumped the winner in upper stretch then straightened and drifted out in the final furlong while second best. MIGHTY MONSOON tracked the pace to the second turn, had to circle four then five wide to the stretch and lacked the needed late response. GAEL MANIA set the pace from off the rail for six furlongs, was overtaken into the stretch and tired. HURRY HOME CLOVER stalked the pace two wide to the second turn but gave way in the drive. TAYLOR MARINI had no speed and was outrun. SOLD SHORT settled early, tried to respond from the two path on the second turn but stopped in the stretch.
