GENERAL ROYAL, away in good order to stalk the leaders from the outset, moved up to challenge the leaders with a quarter to home, gained command a furlong out and drew off to win with something left. MANILASTERRE, lacked early foot, rallied far wide entering the stretch and finished with good energy. ROADSIDE, went to the front at once, saved ground while setting the pace, but could not resist the closers in the drive. O'RED OF MINE, never far back, made a brief bid nearing the half but failed to sustain his rally. SALISH BULL pressed the pace for a half and tired. DANCING RUNNER raced wide into the first turn and failed to menace. AZAGAL was finished early.
