HIGH LODE edged up inside, shifted out mid turn, was blocked behind a wall of horses, waited patiently, swung back inside and kicked clear before the furlong pole. IN SESSION lagged to the turn, rallied four wide and closed willingly. SEAFIRE was slow into stride, found his best stride turning for home and rallied convincingly along the rail. WHY KNOT US attended the pace from the outside, was closing well but flattened late. CRIMSON STAR lagged from the start and did not reach contention. MILITARY MANDATE attended the early pace, took a brief lead turning for home and gave way. STEAMY STORY showed little. DRIVING CAT attended the pace to the turn on the outside and came up empty in the drive. THUNDER ONE rushed to the early lead and gradually dropped back.
