VICTORY KID never far back, found his best stride in the stretch and edged clear. TRIBESMAN attended the pace to the stretch, held a brief lead but could not hold. HIGH STANDARDS tracked the leaders from the start, remained in contention but could not match strides late. JACK HES TOPS raced in the middle of the field throughout and did not rally. RAINGEAR was slow into stride and did not reach contention. WILD CYCLE showed little. CANDY PULL sprinted up inside to set all the pace to the stretch and gave out. JUNIOR BROWN was never a factor.
