NIKKI NINE broke alertly and quickly moved clear in the opening sixteenth, was joined by MISSY CAN DO and LOVESABLUMIN before reaching the turn, shook those foes in upper stretch and moved clear under steady handling. CARSON'S RUMOR moved three and four wide to challenge outside the winner late in the turn, had aim turning for home but could not go with the winner. SALTY ATTRACTION was three wide on the turn and rallied through the lane with a late run. LOVESABLUMIN showed good speed to challenge inside the winner and MISSY CAN DO going to the turn, checked as MISSY CAN DO came in early in the turn then weakened the remainder. MISSY CAN DO was outprinted in the opening furlong, rushed up to challenge the winner through the turn and have aim nearing the stretch but then had little left in the lane. J. J.'S BOBBLE lunged at the start and came away very slowly then failed to reach contention.
