### Footnotes

GOLD GUY moved up to challenge in late backstretch, dueled into the lane and held KING OF RHYTHM at bay through the drive. KING OF RHYTHM was just off the pace racing outside, bid four wide into the far turn, dueled the winner into the lane and could not get past. HERES MY DEAL made his run heading up the backstretch racing out from the rail, checked as a hole closed entering the far turn, dropped back to swing out six wide into the lane and closed but could not reach the top pair. A RIO HERO was five wide leaving the first turn, remained outside in good striking position, rallied through the lane but came up short. GLENN'S FERRY was a close up factor from along the inside but lacked the needed late response. TOP OF THE HERD showed speed from four wide to edge clear leaving the first turn, remained a factor to the far turn and weakened through that bend. LOST INNOCENCE was just off the early pace weakened outside and weakened. CERVEZA FOR ME was always outrun.
