Footnotes

TICK'S SHADOW followed the early pace from inside CEDAR HILL MISS, settled back and angled out late in the turn to rally four wide into the lane and offered a good late run to wear that one down. CEDAR HILL MISS showed the most early speed racing out from the rail, brought a clear advantage into the lane but could not hold the winner late. LOVELY BARBARA was four wide in the turn and lacked a solid closing run. LADY ORIENT was five and six wide through the turn into the lane and could not threaten late. PRETTY MORGAN chased the leaders while three wide and weakened. LIVE AND LEARN lacked a rally while three wide. S D P HAPPY BOTTOM was not a factor. TIZ PEGGY saved ground and failed to offer a bid. B G GOLDEN EAGLE leaned hard into the side of the gate to get away very slowly and never recovered.
