CHERISHISTHEWORD settled back off the early leaders while four wide, rallied through the far turn to quickly collar the leader and move off then held the margin under steady handling. PACIFIC TSUNAMI saved ground in reach of the pace, could not go with the winner in the lane but moved clear for the place. SCHWARTZBEWITHYOU saved ground to late backstretch, moved up four and five wide through the far turn into the lane but could not sustain the rally. SWEET TIGGER chased the early leader from three wide and weakened. SKWHIRL lacked a solid closing bid while three wide. WARLOCK WARRIOR showed the most early speed to open a clear lead through the opening half mile and tired. LAST TRIBUTE was squeezed back between rivals at the break and was always back. EXPRESS AIR broke into the side of the gate and trailed.
