MADDIE CAT set all the pace from the outside and drew off to be clear under strong handling. ZACK CAPE stalked the pace, moved up six wide at the eighth pole and gained ground gamely in the latter stages. KING TYMATT was off slowly, saved ground throughout and finished willingly to the wire. SUNDAY BLITZ stalked the pace, raced four wide into the upper stretch and had no final winning bid. ANEJO pressed the pace from the inside and weakened. SMOOTH ALY stalked the pace and tired. CAPTAIN CANAVERAL dropped back early, raced five wide in the lane and never menaced. BEN WON'T TELL raced wide around the turn, moved up eight wide into the upper stretch and never was a threat. TAKE A SHOT IN OZ showed little. PARKLANE RAGTIME trailed throughout.
