TONIGHT RAINBOW broke sharply to bid inside rivals going to the turn, took command nearing the lane then was roused upper stretch before being taken in hand through the closing yards to win with something left. LOAN ME A FEN rallied from along the rail into the lane and moved clear for the place while unable to menace the winner. MISSY CAN DO showed her usual speed from three or four wide outside rivals to midway of the turn and weakened in the lane to lose position. CLAYDIF was four and five wide through the turn and moved up but could not close on the top ones. NAKAYAMA JAZZ was angled out through the turn to come four wide into the lane while never a threat. TRACKEM 'N' WACKEM contested the pace from between rivals into the turn and came up empty in the lane. WATER QUINT lacked any speed while two to three wide.
