CRAFTMASTER vied racing out from the rail and inside IT'S A BIG YES, angled about the four path nearing the stretch and edged clear under steady handling. CAMBIE BRIDGE was close up along the inside, continued on to gain the place but could not get to the winner. BEAU SMOKE was outside through the turn to come five wide into the stretch and made a mild run to narrowly miss second. WINTER SUMMIT settled four wide while near the back of the field, angled widest once straightened into the lane and rallied but was too late. IT'S A BIG YES contested the lead from outside the winner to upper stretch and weakened. COUNT COUP tucked in along the rail on the turn and lacked a final closing response. SINGLE BLOSSUM flashed early speed from three wide and weakened. MAKING DREAMS bobbled and lost his footing at the start and failed to threaten. FLYINGSOFREE was outrun.
