KALEBS ABLUMIN moved up to prompt the pace from outside THEE HEMI going to the turn, continued four wide into the lane and finished determinedly to run that rival down in the closing jump. THEE HEMI moved clear soon after the break, made the running from about the three path then held well through the lane but could not keep the winner safe. INCREDIBLE AFFAIR was shuffled back between rivals at the break, recovered to challenge from inside the top pair nearing the lane then could not produce the needed late surge. TRANSEPT'S AFFAIR was just off the leaders racing four wide and lacked a final closing response. PEPPY PELINI saved ground and failed to make a bid. EL PASO BOUND broke into the side of the gate to come away slowly and trailed.
