KID RAMBO showed good speed from inside TIMETOBOOK to contest the lead racing out from the rail, angled to about the four path entering the lane and continued on gamely to hold that one safe in the drive. TIMETOBOOK vied from outside the winner, lost ground while five wide into the lane then rallied back while just up for the place. I SPY WOLFIE was out from the rail in good position just off the leaders then continued on willingly in the lane to narrowly miss second. FIRST CLASS BRASS hesitated at the break to come away last, was taken to the inside and rallied through the turn then continued well in the lane to close ground. HERE COMES MARV vied for the lead from outside rivals to be fanned six wide into the lane then was outfinished for position late. FIGHTING CITY HALL was four and five wide on the turn and lacked the needed late response. CUVEE STAR lacked a solid bid racing four wide. MANOVAN was just off the leaders early racing four wide then weakened nearing the lane. TONIGHT RAINBOW leaned into the side of the gate to come away slowly then was bottled up in traffic heading up the backstretch and failed to menace.
