DUNCAN MISS showed speed racing in the three to four path to edge clear heading up the backstretch then continued on under steady handling to hold a safe margin. DERBY DAY DEBUT pressed the pace outside the winner while never far back, could not match strides in the lane but held her position. CHEROKEE APOLLO stalked the pace from between foes heading up the backstretch, moved to contention three wide on the far turn but could not produce the needed late effort. ANTI VERSARY moved up four wide and continued to improve position. NEVERS TRUMP CARD stalked the pace outside, bid four wide on the far turn then fanned seven wide into the lane and lost position late. BELLE AMERICAN was close up along the inside and tired. RENNAE N NICOLE was angled to the outside heading up the backstretch and failed to offer a bid. GOIN' TO RENO was not a factor racing outside. SECRET SLIDER was always back. MISSION NORTH saved ground, dropped out turning into the stretch and was eased then pulled up in distress but walked off under her own power.
