**Footnotes**

BRINKS BABY bobbed at the break but quickly recovered to contest the lead racing out from the rail and inside C O BARQUEEN, shook off that one in upper stretch and edged away under steady handling. B G NEW IDEA was with the leaders early racing along the inside, bid along the rail into the lane then could not go with the winner while gaining the place. C O BARQUEEN dueled on the pace outside BRINKS BABY from the outset and weakened into the lane. RED HEADED WOMAN stalked the leaders racing three wide and could not produce the needed late run. VIA DI ROMA was along the inside and improved position but lacked a solid closing response. FIREWHIRL failed to mount a rally racing outside. INDIAN STAR weakened racing four wide.
