GAMBLING LADY LUCK lunged then bumped with a rival at the start, stalked the leaders from along the inside to bid through the far turn, rallied clear nearing the sixteenth marker then kept safe late. SHE AROSE forced the early pace outside PROUD STUDENT to bid heading up the backstretch, was headed by the winner turning for home and cleared then rallied back late to cut the margin late. TATUM GIRL dropped back off the early pace saving ground, angled four wide in the far turn and rallied late but could not reach the top pair. LA MALINCHE moved up three and four wide to bid into the far turn and could not sustain the rally. DEVIL WATER lacked a rally racing three to four wide. FLYINTHEPOLARROUTE was not a threat racing outside. SAWYOUINADREAM stalked the leaders while four to five wide to the far turn and weakened. PROUD STUDENT bumped with the winner at the start, showed early speed racing out from the rail and tired.
