TATUM GIRL tracked the leaders from four wide to bid into the far turn, dueled outside YA'LL COME BACK into the lane then held well in the drive to keep safe late. MOOD WINNER saved ground in good position just off the leaders, bid into the lane then continued well in the lane but could not get by the winner. DEPUTY'S WHIRL settled back off the leaders racing two or three wide, angled out nearing the lane to rally five wide and made a late run but could not reach the top pair. BEAUTIFULBROWNEYES stalked the pace from outside and lacked a final closing response. YA'LL COME BACK contested the pace from three wide, continued inside the winner to upper stretch and weakened late. CO SASSY saved ground and lacked a rally. THUNDER GAL contested the early lead racing out from the rail and tired. WILD ABOUT BOYS drifted wide out of the first turn and was always back. WHOSALLBEENINTHERE broke to the outside to come away last and trailed.
