**Footnotes**

I THINK IT IS stalked the leaders from four wide, challenged through the far turn to edge clear turning for home then widened a bit under steady handling. FRIENDLY INCENTIVE trailed the field early, angled out heading up the backstretch to launch his rally four and five wide through the far turn, rallied clear for the place but could not threaten the winner. B G GIFT EXCHANGE rallied to contention while two and three wide in the far turn then lacked a final closing response. BRAZOS EGO was on the pace from three wide to edge clear in late backstretch then had nothing left nearing the lane. MINIMAL RISK settled just off the pace racing three and four wide, made a run at the leaders in the far turn but weakened. NO SHUG TONIGHT was with the leaders early and settled back just off the pace, remained in reach to the far turn and weakened. SLY SPY lacked a rally racing outside. TWISTER IN OZ showed speed from along the inside and tired.
